- The Government of Kenya has received financing from the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany, through KfW Development Bank, to undertake the Nairobi Satellite Towns Water and Sanitation Development Programme, Phase 1. The Project is being implemented by Athi Water Services Board, a parastatal under the Ministry of Water and Sanitation.
- Athi Water Services Board now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Construction of the Ruiru-Juja / Greater Githurai Water Supply System – Lot 1. The Works consist of:
 - Construction of Upgrading of the Jacaranda Water Treatment Plant from 15,000 m³/d to 28,000 m³/d consisting of Inlet structure, 2 No. Flocculation basins, 2 No. Sedimentation tanks, 4 No. Rapid Gravity Sand Filters and Gravity Sludge Drying Beds
 - Construction of dedicated transmission main 6.8 km DN 1000 ferrous pipe from Jacaranda Water Treatment plant to Ruiru.
 - Construction of dedicated transmission main 6.1 km DN 800 ferrous pipe from Ruiru to Githurai (Kahawa Sukari)
 - Construct 168 km of ring mains and distribution network in Greater Githurai area of Kiuu, Mwiki, Kahawa Wendani and Kahawa Sukari (OD63 to DN800):
 - Supply and install 73 km OD 25 – OD 63 HDPE for 5,200 number consumer connections
 - Supply operation and maintenance equipment

The Construction Period is **18 Months**

- Bidding will be conducted through the **International Competitive Bidding (ICB)** procedures as specified in the **KfW Guidelines for Procurement of Goods, Works and associated Services in Financial Cooperation with Partner Countries** (May 2007 and updated in September 2013). The Guidelines can be downloaded from www.kfw-entwicklungsbank.de/International-financing/KfW-Development-Bank/Publications/Guidelines. Bidding is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the KfW Guidelines.
- Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the address specified below and inspect the Bidding Documents during office hours from 8.00am to 5.00pm local time from Monday to Friday, except during lunch hour (1.00pm to 2.00pm), weekends and public holidays.
- A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of **KSh. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand only)** or equivalent in a freely convertible currency. The method of payment will be **Cash or Banker's Cheque**. The Bidding Documents will be collected from the address given below upon production of a purchase receipt.
- A **mandatory** Pre-Bid Meeting and Site Visit will take place at the address specified below on **Wednesday 03rd October 2018 starting at 1000hrs East African Time at AWSB 3rd Floor Boardroom**. The Pre-bid Meeting and Site Visit are **compulsory** for any firm intending to submit a bid.
- Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **1200hrs East African Time on Thursday 1st November 2018**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on **Thursday 1st November 2018 at 1205hrs East African Time**.
- All bids must be accompanied by a bid security of **KSh. 7,000,000.00 (Kenya Shillings Seven Million)** or equivalent amount in Euro.
